

## Frequently Asked Questions

- ❖ Is TECE 1 and TECE 2 available separately, as two courses, **in-person**?
  - Yes. Contact a program provider above to inquire about schedule.
- ❖ Is TECE 1 and TECE 2 available separately, as two courses, **online**?
  - No. TECE 1 and 2 must be taken together as it is only offered as a complete training package of 120 hours.
- ❖ Can I take TECE 1 in person and then finish online or vice versa?
  - No. You must complete the 120 hours of coursework in the same program format.
- ❖ Which CDA Credential “type” will be accepted for TECE 1 and 2?
  - Online training organizations often offer Infant/Toddler, Preschool, and Family Child Care CDA Credentials. All three of these credential types are accepted for TECE 1 and 2. Choose the program that fits best based on the children you plan to support.
- ❖ Am I able to finish online coursework that I have started with Collaboration (Cypherworx)?
  - Because third party companies (not the Office of Early Learning) offer online TECE 1 and 2 coursework, professionals must speak directly with the company to learn all of the company’s policies. However, the Office of Early Learning has confirmed that Collaboration will no longer be offering online coursework that Delaware accepts for TECE 1 and 2 as of January 2019. Anyone who previously signed up to complete TECE 1 and 2 through Collaboration has *one year from the start of coursework* to complete their 120 hours of training.
